
Jennifer H.

She was adjunct faculty member at both Salisbury University and Wor Wic Community College where she taught

nursing students both didactically and on a pediatric medical surgical floor setting. She is a member of the American Epilepsy Society, as well as the American Association of Neuroscience Nurses.

In 2023, Jennifer was nominated for the Rising Star Advanced Professional Nurse and in 2024 the Exemplary Professional Practice. This year she is receiving the Eric Burton Osberg Award from the Epilepsy Foundation of Eastern PA for her volunteer work with epilepsy.

She continues her mission to advocate for epilepsy patients through a quality improvement project on Anxiety and Depression, as well as her volunteer work at Camp Achieve and representing Nemours at epilepsy walks, such as Reagans Run and Walk to End Epilepsy.



She serves on the Professional Advisory Board (PAB) for the Epilepsy Foundation of Delaware and is a resource for the Nemours Neurology Parent Group.
